### A BEAUTIFUL BRITISH TOWN


Sunbury-on-Thames, also known as Sunbury,isatowninSurrey,boroughofSpelthorne, England. Part of the London commuterbelt, it is located 16 miles southwest of central London and is shares borders with Feltham, Hampton and is flanked on thesouthbytheriverThames.

Sunbury has two areas divided by the M3. Lower Sunbury, (known as Sunbury Village,) largely residential southern portion of the town including the majority of Sunbury's schoolsand parkland.

The northern section is Sunbury Common andhouses many of Sunbury's businesses including Chubb and BP. The M3 and the large roundabout Sunbury Cross divides to the two sections and has as mall shopping arcade.

### A PRIMELOCATION

The Siteislocated on the corner of the junction between Staines Road West and Green Lane, with predominantly twoborderstheriver Thames and makes up the storey residential buildings to the north and west but a range of multi-storey buildings in the immediate vicinity.



Locations in Central London such as Victoria Station, are reached in as little as 52 minutes ^, while London Bridge Station can be reached in 41 minutes ^. Equally, from both of these stations, the rearefrequents ervices to King's Cross St Pancras which connects younot only to destination soutside of London but to Europe as well.

## CLOSER TO EXCEPTIONAL SCHOOLS — PRIMARY & SECONDARY EDUCATION

Schools in Richmond boast an excellent education experience with grades often exceeding the national average. The proximity of Richmond to London means families relocating from abroad will be spoilt for choice when finding primary and secondary schools for their educational needs.

### OUTSTANDING PERFORMANCE

Despite the ever more challenging frameworks for inspection introduced by the Office for Standards in Education, Children's Services and Skills, the percentage of schools judged good or better in their most recent inspection has risen year on year. Richmond boasts many local primary and secondary

schools with a rating of 'good' to 'outstanding' by(OFSTED), achieving tremendous examination results well above the national average.

Richmond upon Thames is known for having some of the leading independent schools in the country. The borough has 41 primary schools, voted amongst the best in England, of which 15 of these are Church schools.

Three of the eight secondary schools have become academies; seven are mixed and one

Of particular note Ofsted's quarterly report said of the primary schools inspected across the borough of Richmond, 21 were rated as outstanding.

is for girls only.

Richmond Upon Thames continues its role in ensuring all schools make progress towards excellence and has demonstrated excellent results in terms of capacity to meet the educational needs of young people.

The most recent analysis of the annual figures shows that from reception classes to post 16 A-Levels, Richmond's pupils overall often do better than those of similar ages elsewhere in the UK.
